DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your state or tribe, consult the agency in your state responsible for pesticide regulation.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Chemical-resistant gloves made of material such as barrier laminate or Viton®
- Chemical-resistant footwear plus socks
- Protective eyewear (goggles, face-shield, or safety glasses)
- When mixing and loading wear a chemical-resistant apron

Follow the manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated such as plants, soil, or water, is:

- Coveralls worn over short-sleeved shirt and short pants
- Chemical-resistant gloves made of material such as barrier laminate or Viton
- Chemical-resistant footwear plus socks
- Protective eyewear (goggles, face-shield, or safety glasses)

Restricted Entry Interval (REI)

- Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 12 hours.

Do not make applications if bees are foraging in the treatment area.

Thorough spray coverage is critical to obtain control of the target pest(s).• Apply when pest populations are beginning to build.
